#### LAND AT 6 LOWDEN HILL, CHIPPENHAM, WILTSHIRE

I enclose by way of service upon you a Notice pursuant to Section 215 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

This Notice has been served on you as it appears to this Council, as the Local Planning Authority, that the amenity of part of the district is adversely affected by the condition of your property, 6 Lowden Hill. The Notice specifies the steps considered necessary to remedy the condition of the land. The Council requires the steps specified in the Notice to be carried out within the period of one month from the date the Notice takes effect, that is 8 September 1996.

You do have a right of appeal to the local Magistrates' Court. If you wish to appeal, you should do so in writing and address it to The Clerk to the Justices, 10 Market Place, Chippenham, SN15 3HD. Any appeal must be lodged with the Court before 8 August 1996.

The statutory grounds upon which you may appeal are as follows:-

- a) That the condition of the land to which the Notice relates does not adversely affect the amenity of any part of the area of the Local Planning Authority who served the Notice or of any adjoining area;
- b) that the condition of the land to which the Notice relates is attributable to, and such as results in the ordinary course of events from the carrying on of operations or a use of land which is not in contravention of Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990;



- c) that the requirements of the Notice exceed what is necessary for preventing the condition of the land from adversely affecting the amenity of any part of the area of the Local Planning Authority who served the Notice or of any adjoining area;
- d) That the period specified in the Notice as the period within which any steps required by the Notice are to be taken falls short of what should reasonably be allowed.

I must point out to you that this Notice is an important document and that if, as the owner of the land, you fail to take the steps required by the Notice within the period specified, you may be guilty of an offence. If you wish to discuss the requirements of the Notice or its effect, I suggest you telephone or write to my Assistant Solicitor, Mr Taylor (Extension 598).


