



EXAMPLE:	8400..... parcel number	
	1-8200..... area in metres	
	4-47..... area in acres	

When identifying a parcel it is important to specify the number of the plan on which it falls.

Enclosures or features joined for measurement of area are shown as follows:

Limits of area within which individual parcels are not shown

To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.4705

To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.4047

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:—

EXAMPLE:	G in Galloway
EASTING	NORTHING
Take west edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the east or south margin	Take south edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the west or south margin
Estimate some of metres from grid line to the point	Estimate some of metres from grid line to the point
